Minimising the risk of insect attack, this typically expensive process is included right out-of-the-box. With Australia's changing climate bringing a rise in termite activity, this is a must have feature for construction materials.

Hardwood Flooring is available in 2400 x 1200mm while Softwood is available in both 2400 x 1200mm and 2700 x 1200mm. Both options come in a full range of thicknesses from 12mm - 25mm, providing even more customization and ensuring you find the perfect fit for your space.
